## Event

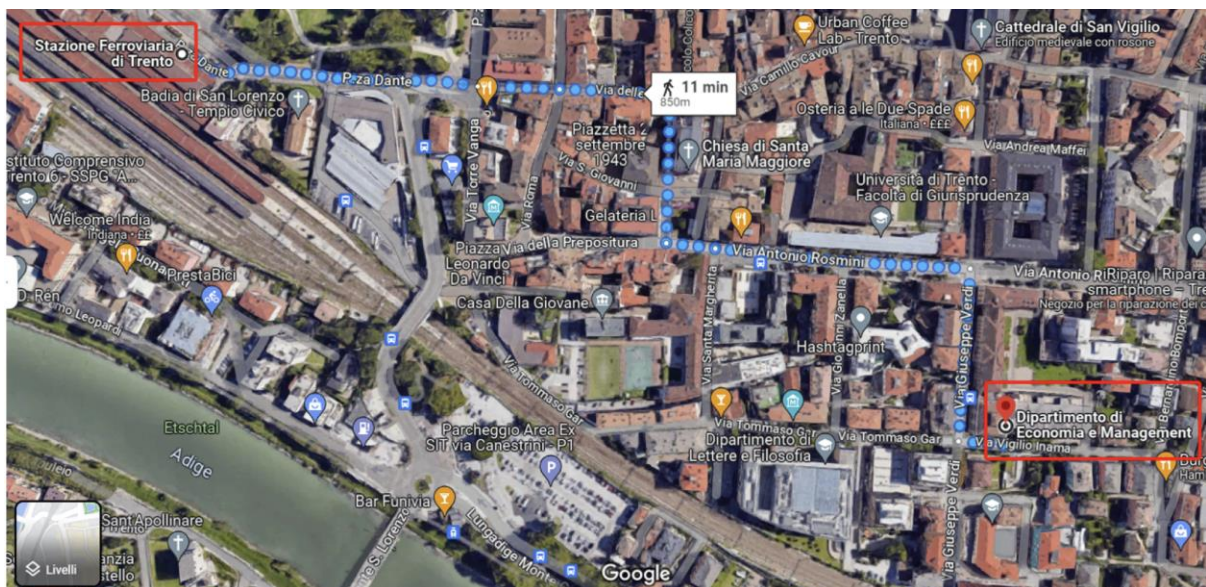
