When and Where	<p>The Winter School starts in Trento on Monday morning, 27 January and will finish on Friday afternoon, 7 February 2025.</p> <p>For further details check the SustANGE Winter School webpage</p>
Enrolment Confirmation and Visa (if needed)	<p>Once your payment has been finalized, we will send you the Enrolment confirmation and, if a visa is needed, your invitation letter. Check whether a visa is needed by selecting your nationality, country of residence, “up to 90 days” and “tourism” options. If you need a visa, please immediately send us the complete name and address of the Italian Embassy/General Consulate in your country where you will go to apply for the visa.</p>
Insurance Coverage	<p>Make sure you have health insurance coverage valid in Italy for the entire period of your stay. If you live in the EU and you have a valid European Health Insurance Card, please refer to this webpage.</p> <p>Otherwise, you will need to buy a private health insurance policy, which covers emergencies and guarantees your return to your country in case of serious health problems. Among the several choices to consider, you can have a look at Aon Complete Formula which also covers accidents outside academic activities. During all activities organized by UniTrento you are covered by UniTrento accident insurance (only in case of hospitalization due to an accident) and by third party liability (in case of damages you may cause to third parties). Please notice that these are not personal health insurance policies!</p>
Travel Plans	<p>You are required to pay for and organize all travel from your place of residence to Trento and back on your own. There is not a designated student pick-up service in Trento. The Verona-Catullo airport is the closest airport to Trento (20 minutes by shuttle + 1 hour by train), but there are also airports in Milan, Bergamo and Venice. All details and shuttle connections to the closest train station can be found on the webpage How to arrive to Trento. Alternatively, FLIXBUS is a cheap way of travelling from the main airports to Trento also during the night. If you come by car the highway is the A22 Brennero-Modena and the closest exit to the city center is Trento sud or Trento nord, depending on which direction you are coming from.</p>
Weather and What to Bring	<p>The weather in Trento during the Winter can be quite cold (-5 to +8°C) with occasional rain and/or snow, so please bring warm clothes and waterproof shoes. In particular for those of you who enjoy skiing, bring waterproof trousers, jacket, gloves, sunglasses and a wool hat!</p> <p>Wi-fi is available in UniTrento spaces by using your UniTrento full user credentials.</p>

IT UniTrento full user credentials for Wi-Fi	<p>A couple of weeks before the School starts, after your official enrollment at UniTrento, you will receive an e-mail from the University with the subject: "UniTrento: how to activate your definitive account". This is a very important e-mail so please check in the Spam box as well in case you did not receive it. The e-mail explains how to turn your "guest" profile into a "UniTrento" profile, which is necessary to access the Internet and all ICT services on campus. In order to receive your UniTrento account, you have to go to the section "MyUniTn" in the upper right-hand corner of UniTrento HP and sign in using your provisional account that is included in the e-mail (name.surname@guest.unitn.it) and follow the instructions given in the e-mail. In case of problems, please write to account.help@unitn.it</p> <p>Once you complete this procedure, your guest account will be disabled and you will be a full-fledged UniTn user though which you will be able to use Wi-Fi UNITN-X or EDURAM. If you do not remember your password, a "UniTrento password recovery service" is available that only requires your personal email address. Please notice that you are not asked to activate the unitn mailbox which requires several steps and you do not need it.</p>
Accommodation	<p>You are responsible for booking and covering the entire cost of your own lodging in Trento for the duration of the School.</p> <p>Admitted students will receive some hints of modern, central and economically convenient accommodation according to past editions students' suggestions.</p> <p>Make sure to book ahead of time. Ask for and clearly understand the payment and cancellation policy, as well as additional services that may be available (e.g. cleaning, special requests, breakfast, kitchenette, etc.).</p> <p>Since lessons start on Monday morning and finish on Friday afternoon of the following week, we suggest that you plan your check-in by Sunday evening 26 January and the checkout starting from Friday 7 February 2025.</p> <p>Through the Padlet that will be created soon after the selection, you can contact the other students for a shared accommodation.</p>
Meals	<p>You will receive an electronic badge that can be used from Monday 27 January to Friday 7 February evening at the university restaurant in Via T. Gar 18, 2 minutes walking from the School.</p> <p>The welcome coffee break, the lunch during the one-day excursion and the farewell lunch are also covered by UniTrento.</p> <p>Breakfasts are not included in the meal plan and are at your expense.</p>
