What and when	<p>Summer School SLICE- Stories of Linguistic and Cultural Encounters from 23 June to 4 July 2025, Department of Humanities, Trento</p> <p>Summer School NEMESI - Narration of Explorative Maps and Virtual Experience of Architectural Spaces. Imagine Trento from 30 June to 11 July 2025, Department of Environmental and Mechanical Engineering, Mesiano, Trento</p>
Admission process and visa (if needed)	<p>Once you are admitted to one of the above Summer Schools, we will inform you and the International Office of your Home Institution (contact provided by you in the application tool). In case you are within the frame of an Erasmus+ short term mobility for BIP (Blended Intensive Program), we will provide details about the needed process.</p> <p>If a visa is needed, your invitation letter. Check whether a visa is needed by selecting your nationality, country of residence, “up to 90 days” and “tourism” options. If you need a visa, please immediately send us the complete name and address of the Italian Embassy/General Consulate in your country where you will go to apply for the visa.</p>
ECTS Credits	<p>At the end of the School, all participants will receive an Attendance Certificate. In order to receive an official UniTrento Transcript of Records with 6 ECTS, external international students have to attend the scheduled online follow-up online. In order to obtain 2 more ECTS (8 ECTS total) and an evaluation mark, external students must choose a topic and have it agreed with the Academic coordinators during the School. On the first day of the second week you will be asked to inform us about your interest in the 2 extra ECTS. See for the details the Assessment Tasks documents on the dedicated webpage of the School.</p>
Insurance Coverage	<p>Make sure you have health insurance coverage valid in Italy for the entire period of your stay. If you live in the EU and you have a valid European Health Insurance Card, please refer to this webpage.</p> <p>Otherwise, you will need to buy a private health insurance policy, which covers emergencies and guarantees your return to your country in case of serious health problems. Among the several choices to consider, you can have a look at Aon Complete Formula which also covers accidents outside academic activities. During all activities organized by UniTrento you are covered by UniTrento accident insurance (only in case of hospitalization due to an accident) and by third party liability (in case of damages you may cause to third parties). Please notice that these are not personal health insurance policies!</p>
Travel Plans	<p>You are required to pay for and organize all travel from your place of residence to Trento and back on your own. There is not a designated student pick-up service in Trento. The Verona-Catullo airport is the closest airport to Trento (20 minutes by shuttle + 1 hour by train), but there are also airports in Milan, Bergamo and Venice. All details and shuttle connections to the closest train station can be found on the webpage How to arrive to Trento. Alternatively, FLIXBUS is a cheap way of travelling from the main airports to Trento also during the night. If you come by car the highway is the A22 Brennero-Modena and the closest exit to the city center is Trento sud (South) or Trento nord (North), depending on which direction you are coming from.</p>

<p>Weather and What to Bring</p>	<p>The weather in the region during the Summer is usually sunny and quite warm (up to 35°C). However, it can also be rainy at times with afternoon storms, so a rain jacket and waterproof shoes are recommended. We are going to spend a day at the lake, where we will do water sports and relax on the beach. Make sure you bring your swimming costume, flip-flops, a small picnic blanket or towel, a hat, sunscreen and sunglasses.</p> <p>For NEMESI Summer School bring your laptop and at least one notebook (A5 or A4) for drawing from life and -if already in one's possession- tablet, GoPro and camera.</p> <p>For NEMESI Summer School if possible, personal laptop with the installation of the following software:</p> <p>Rhinoceros</p> <p>Blender (open source) previous registration on EpigGames</p> <p>Twinmotion (open source)</p> <p>Photoshop, Indesign, Illustrator</p> <p>Gimp, Inkscape, DaVinci Resolve (open source as an alternative to the adobe package)</p> <p>Pano2VR (trial version)</p> <p>Metashape or alternative</p>
<p>IT UniTrento full user credentials for Wi-Fi</p>	<p>A couple of weeks before the School starts, after your official enrollment at UniTrento, you will receive an e-mail from the University with the subject: "UniTrento: how to activate your definitive account". This is a very important e-mail so please check in the Spam box as well in case you did not receive it. The e-mail explains how to turn your "guest" profile into a "UniTrento" profile, which is necessary to access the Internet and all ICT services on campus. In order to receive your UniTrento account, you have to go to the section "MyUniTn" in the upper right-hand corner of UniTrento HP and sign in using your provisional account that is included in the e-mail (name.surname@guest.unitn.it) and follow the instructions given in the e-mail. In case of problems, please write to account.help@unitn.it</p> <p>Once you complete this procedure, your guest account will be disabled and you will be a full-fledged UniTn user though which you will be able to use Wi-Fi UNITN-X or EDURAM. If you do not remember your password, a "UniTrento password recovery service" is available that only requires your personal email address. Please notice that you are NOT asked to activate the unitn mailbox which requires several steps and you do not need it.</p>
<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>You are responsible for booking and covering the entire cost of your own lodging in Trento for the duration of the School.</p> <p>Admitted students will receive some hints of modern, central and economically convenient accommodation according to past editions students' suggestions.</p> <p>Make sure to book ahead of time. Ask for and clearly understand the payment and cancellation policy, as well as additional services that may be available (e.g. cleaning, special requests, breakfast, kitchenette, etc.).</p> <p>Since lessons start on Monday morning and finish on Friday afternoon of the following week, we suggest that you plan your check-in by Sunday evening before the School start and the check-out starting from Saturday morning of the second week.</p> <p>Through the Padlet that will be created soon after the selection, you can contact the other students for a shared accommodation.</p>

Meals	<p>We will provide you some vouchers in order to access the university canteen at an affordable price.</p> <p>Otherwise, you can decide to have your meals in a restaurant/café at your choice and without showing the vouchers.</p> <p>During the first day you will receive a document with all our best recommendations.</p> <p>The welcome coffee break, the lunch during the one-day excursion and the farewell lunch are covered by UniTrento.</p>
Costs of living	<p>At your charge and under your responsibility are:</p> <p>Meals: approximately from 5.89 to 9.07 euros (€) in the university canteen, 15-30 € at a café or restaurant, less if you cook by yourself or with others</p> <p>Housing: approximately 35 €/day in shared accommodation, hints to find one will be sent to prospective participants</p> <p>Travel and transportation expenses once you arrive at UniTrento and the surrounding area unless you get from your host the Trentino Guest Card.</p> <p>Visa and health insurance, if needed.</p>
