ABSTRACT

The talk will address the complex relationship between climate and the economy, considering both directions of influence. On one hand, it will examine the impact of economic activities on the climate system, with particular attention to international targets aimed at keeping global warming well below two degrees Celsius. On the other hand, it will explore the effects of climate on the economy, from both historical and forward-looking perspectives. It will conclude by offering a perspective on how economic policies as well as simple socio-economic decisions can help the climate.
