# Student Inclusion Community Service



## Who is it for?

**The Student Community Inclusion Service is aimed at all students with permanent or temporary disabilities, with Specific Learning Disorders (SLD), or with other special needs enrolled at the University of Trento.**

Specifically, the service is intended for those who are about to take admission tests for restricted-enrolment degree programmes, as well as for students already enrolled in:

- degree programmes
- single courses
- PhD programmes
- international mobility programmes
- specialization schools



## Main objectives:

- Ensure the right to inclusive education and participation in the various aspects of university life
- Ensure equal treatment and respect for the specific needs of the entire student community
- Facilitate continuity of the educational path and the accessibility of facilities, services, and benefits by adopting all possible measures and tools offered by the University of Trento

## Examples of actions and tools:

- **Compensatory and exemption measures for exams** benefiting students with disabilities, specific learning disorders, or other special educational needs  
Tutoring for peer of orientation or to specific subjects
- **Peer tutoring** for orientation or specific subjects
- **Loan of dedicated software and devices** (Smart Pen, speech synthesis, etc.)
- **Physical accompaniment service** for people with physical and sensory disabilities
- **Collection of teaching materials in accessible formats** according to specific needs
- **SLD Helpdesk** relating to Specific Learning Disorders
- **Neurodiversity Helpdesk** for neurodivergent students at the University of Trento


