Activities start on Monday morning, **14 September 2026** and finish on Wednesday day afternoon, **24 September 2026**.

• Final screening and Fee Payment

After the publication of the ranking list, you will receive the details for the payment of the participation costs (if needed). Only after the payment has been confirmed, will your enrolment be considered effective. The participation costs must be **paid by 28 August 2026**.

The Summer School's Euregio Committee will award six fee waivers – two to students from UNITN, two from UNIBZ, and two from UIBK. The selected recipients will be announced together with the ranking list and will be exempt from paying the €300 participation fee.

Please note, that there are 2 scholarships for each university. In case Euregio students might not get the scholarship, they can still take part in the summer school by paying the €300,00 participation fee.

- **Enrolment confirmation and Visa (if needed)**

Once your payment has been finalised, we will send you the **Enrolment confirmation** and, if a visa is needed, **your invitation letter**. Check whether a [visa](#) is needed by selecting your nationality, country of residence, “up to 90 days” and “tourism” options. If you need a visa, please **immediately** send us **the complete name and address of the Italian Embassy/General Consulate** in your country, where you will go to apply for the visa.

- **Insurance coverage**

Make sure you have **health insurance** coverage valid in Italy for the entire period of your stay. **If you live in the EU** and you have a valid European Health Insurance Card, please refer to [this webpage](#). **Otherwise**, you will need to buy a private health insurance policy, which covers emergencies and guarantees your return to your country in case of serious health problems, including COVID-related hospitalisation and treatment. Among the several choices to consider, you can have a look at [Aon Complete Formula](#), which also covers accidents outside academic activities. During all activities organised by UniTrento you are covered by **UniTrento accident insurance** (only in case of hospitalisation due to an accident) and by **third party liability** (in case of damages you may cause to third parties). Please notice that these are not personal health insurance policies!

- **Travel Plans**

You are required to pay for and organise all travel from your place of residence to Rovereto and back on your own. There is not a designated student pick-up service in Rovereto. The Verona-Catullo airport is the closest airport to Rovereto (20 minutes by shuttle + 1 hour by train), but there are also airports in Milan, Bergamo-Oro al Serio and Venice. All details and shuttle connections to the closest train station can be found on the webpage [How to arrive to UniTrento](#). Alternatively, [FLIXBUS](#) is a cheap way of travelling from the main airports to Rovereto, also during the night. If you come by car, the highway is the A22 Brennero-Modena and the closest exit to the city center is Rovereto Nord (the other one is Rovereto Sud).

- **Accommodation**

You are responsible for booking and covering the entire cost of your own lodging in Rovereto for the duration of the PsyHuman School. We suggest the [Youth Hostel](#) which is near the Department of Psychology and Cognitive Science. It is very modern, well equipped and you can find 2, 3 or 4-bed rooms with breakfast included at very convenient prices. Or, if you

prefer, you can opt for one of the following alternatives: [Air B&B – Rovereto](#), [Booking.com – Rovereto](#), [More hotels - from UniTrento](#) webpage, see Rovereto section. When you book, ask for and clearly understand the payment and cancellation policy, as well as additional services that may be available (e.g. cleaning, special requests, breakfast, kitchenette, etc.). Since lessons start on Monday morning and finish on Wednesday afternoon of the following week, we suggest that you plan **your check-in by Sunday evening 13 September and the checkout starting from Thursday 25 September**.

Through the **Padlet** that will be created soon after the selection, you can contact the other students for a shared accommodation. Rovereto is a tiny town and popular with tourists, so please make sure to book ahead of time.

The Hostel and the hotels provide [Trentino Guest Card](#), in all other cases (e.g. private owners such as Air B&B), you might not have it. This card gives you free access to some museums, all public transportation within the province of Trento and discounts at participating vendors. When you book, ask if you have right to it, and at the check in, ask it to be activated. **Please let us know in advance** if you will have the Card. This Card is welcome (if you have it) for the workshop at the Contemporary Art Museum (MART). UniTrento will cover the entrance tickets to the museum for those of you who might not have it.

- **Meals**

Lunch breaks on weekdays are normally **2 hours** to give you enough time to eat lunch and rest. You will receive **meal vouchers lunches on weekdays in Rovereto** in the University restaurant Gilda (Via Prati, 3/b on the corner of Via Matteo del Ben). You can check the daily menu and list of allergens by using the Opera4U App, more information will be provided. This cost will be covered by UniTrento. You can have either a “full” or “partial” meal and make sure the cashier takes notice of which one you choose. The full meal consists of 3 pieces, the partial consists of 2 pieces. **Dinners** are at your charge. The welcome brunch, the lunch during the one-day excursion, the lunch during the day in Bolzano, and the farewell lunch are covered by UniTrento. Breakfast and weekend meals are not included in the meal plan.

- **Wheather and What to bring**

September in Rovereto is usually warm and pleasant, with daytime temperatures ranging from 20°C to 27°C. Evenings can be cooler, and occasional rain showers are possible. We recommend bringing light summer clothes, a light sweater or jacket for the evenings, comfortable walking shoes, and a small umbrella or rain jacket.

If you are planning excursions in the mountains with walk on trails, we suggest that you bring a small backpack, long pants, a fleece jacket or sweater, a small picnic blanket or towel, a hat, sunscreen and sunglasses. We recommend that you bring a power bank for your laptop computer.

Wi-fi is available in UniTrento spaces by using your UniTrento full user credentials.

- **Attendance certificare and ECTS credits**

At the end of the School, all participants will receive an **Attendance Certificate**. If you also want an official **UniTrento Transcript of Records** with 6 ECTS, external international students have to attend the scheduled online follow-up. See for the details the Assessment Tasks documents on the dedicated webpage of the PsyHuman School.

Please, ask at your students' support desk if this extracurricular activity can be recognised in terms of credits or thesis points or extra credits, according to the rules of your course.

- **IT UniTrento full user credentials for Wi-Fi**

After your official enrollment at UniTrento, you will receive an e-mail from the University with the subject: **"UniTrento: how to activate your definitive account"**. This is a very important e-mail so please check in the Spam box as well in case you did not receive it. The e-mail explains how to turn your "guest" profile into a "UniTrento" profile, which is necessary to access **the Internet and all ICT services on campus**. In order to receive your UniTrento account, you have to go to the section "[MyUniTn](#)" in the upper right-hand corner of UniTrento HP and sign in using your provisional account that is included in the e-mail (name.surname@guest.unitn.it) and follow the instructions given in the e-mail. In case of problems, please write to account.help@unitn.it.

Once you complete this procedure, your guest account will be disabled and you will be a full-fledged UniTn user through which you will be able to use Wi-Fi UNITN-X or EDUROAM. If you do not remember your password, a "[UniTrento password recovery service](#)" is available that only requires your personal email address. Please notice that you are not asked to activate unitn mailbox which requires several steps and you do not need it.
